


This development is in San Jose on Campbell Avenue, by the El Paseo Mall



Compare Existing to Proposed

These pictures were taken from the same relative height (about seven feet off the ground).

These new houses will be more than twice as big as the existing homes.



Again, look at the relative size of the existing home on the left on Henry vs. a SummerHill Home on the right. Use the pickup truck as a gauge




Look at the proposed density compared to existing conditions




These just do not go together



Is this what you are comparing to “like houses?”




