Former BAREC Property 90 N. Winchester Boulevard Santa Clara, California August 4, 2006



## Weed Abatement being conducted on August 11, 2006

The City of Santa Clara and the California Department of General Services (DGS) are distributing this courtesy work notification to advise you of weed abatement work at the former BAREC property located at 90 N. Winchester Boulevard. DGS's contractor will be performing the work.

DGS will be mowing weeds and overgrown vegetation at the site for fire prevention purposes. Any areas containing chemicals of concern will be marked and avoided. The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is aware of the proposed work. DTSC is the California state agency that has authority over property believed to be contaminated by chemicals and has assisted DGS in developing procedures to minimize the dust caused by the mowing.

Workers will be on the former BAREC property between 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. The weed abatement should take one day. The following work activities will happen:

- The work will be done inside fenced property owned by the State of California. No public streets will be blocked and there should not be a major impact on area parking.
- The areas on the site that have been identified as containing chemicals of concern will be marked. These areas will not be mowed to avoid disturbing the soil.
- A mower pulled behind a tractor will be used to mow the weeds on the rest of the property to a height of about 2 to 3 inches.
- A water truck will follow the mower to spray water to control dust.
- Workers have been advised of the chemicals of concern on the property.
